Polyglutamic Acids

What is Polyglutamic Acid?

Polyglutamic acid (PGA) is a biopolymer
 of the amino acid glutamic acid that
 is formed when many glutamic acid molecules
 are linked together.

 PGA is a natural molecule of D and L glutamic acid originally isolated from traditional soybean foods, natto/chunkookjang, that are widely consumed in Japan, Korea and China.

 In the industrial manufacture of PGA, a non-GMO Bacillus subtilis strain obtained from chunkookjang is used in a controlled fermentation method.

What does it do?

- PGA acts as a humectant, which means it
 attracts water into cells and forms a protective
 layer on your skin to keep water from
 evaporating. It can hold five times as much
 water as hyaluronic acid.
- Restores cell hydration and reduces the appearance of wrinkles and pores.
- PGA improves skin elasticity and helps to seal moisture in the skin.
- High molecular PGA sits on top of the skin, making it glow and more luminescent. It moisturises the skin while also giving it a plumper appearance.
- The loss of hyaluronic acid (HA) in the skin, which is broken down by an enzyme called hyaluronidase, is a part of the ageing process.
 PGA-containing products help to inhibit the action of hyaluronidase, resulting in more HA in the skin and a more moisturised, rejuvenated, and hydrated appearance.



- It's perfect for people who have dry or dehydrated skin. It complements other skincare compounds well, especially HA.
- By combining both HA and PGA within your skin care routine, you're ensuring that you hydrate the lowest levels of your skin, and "seal in" the upper levels, resulting in an overall moisturisation.
- High molecular PGA has excellent sensory
 qualities that help to reduce the stickiness of a
 formulation.
- Immediate and long-lasting skin moisturisation.
